We were there during its conception and birth, and we will continue to walk alongside you throughout its implementation. Together with UN-Habitat, we will ensure the necessary coordination, visibility, and resource mobilization to sustain this transformative work.
9. I wish to commend the Governments of Kenya and Uganda, and the local leadership of Busia County and Busia District, for their dedication to this shared agenda. Your political will and collaborative spirit are what make such visionary projects possible.
